### Indonesian Update - Ibu Stuart

Over the past few weeks, students in Grades Three to Six have been working very well to complete their portfolio tasks. Grade Three students have had fun memorising and performing Indonesian role-plays, Grade Four students have made creative family posters, Grade Five students have been writing, illustrating and recording letters/post-cards about themselves, and in Grade Six, students have nearly completed books about endangered animals (in Indonesian!) which they will be sharing with their Foundation buddies later this term.



### Foundation

Students in *Fondasi* have really enjoyed learning songs, greetings, numbers and colours. They've also shared *Where is the Green Sheep?* in Indonesian and created their own green sheep mini books. They've loved hiding the *domba hijau* (green sheep) and giving clues using the words *panas* (hot) and *dingin* (cold)!
